Spokane County Fire District 8 is recruiting for **Lateral Firefighter/Paramedic** candidates to fill two immediate openings. Estimated starting date for these positions is March 13, 2018.

Minimum qualifications include:

- 18 years old.
- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- IFSAC Firefighter 1, or equivalent, as determined at the sole discretion of the District.
- IFSAC Hazardous Materials Operations, or equivalent, as determined at the sole discretion of the District.
- Current State of Washington or National Registry Paramedic certification with the ability to gain reciprocity in Washington.
- Current driver's license with an acceptable driving record.
- Minimum of one year experience as a full-time, fully compensated Firefighter/Paramedic.

Salary and Benefits information:

- 2018 Salary to begin at Step B or C of the 2018 pay scale per the current IAFF Local 3711 contract. Beginning step level will be determined based on experience and confirmed by the Fire Chief.
- 10% Paramedic premium pay begins on first day of employment.
- Vacation and Sick Leave to be provided on first day of employment, with the employee choosing between 72 hours of annual leave and 48 hours of sick leave, or 48 hours of annual leave and 72 hours of sick leave.
- Vacation accrual will reflect years of service as a full-time, fully compensated Firefighter/Paramedic with prior employers.

Application packets submitted shall include only the following items:

- Completed SCFD 8 Application.
- Resume.
- Current Drivers Abstract.
- Veterans Preference Points Form (if applicable).
- Copies certifications listed above under "Minimum qualifications."
- Applications must be received by 4:00pm on December 22, 2017.

The testing process shall consist of the following steps:

- Panel interview.
- Paramedic practical skills evaluation.
- Candidate Physical Agility Test.
- Medical exam and drug screen.
- Background check, psychological exam, and suitability assessment
