

# SPOKANE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 8

## POSITION DESCRIPTION

### **Temporary- Hourly Firefighter**

#### **Basic Function:**

Performs functions of fire suppression, rescue, emergency medical treatment, operation of fire apparatus, and performs other assigned duties necessary to support the mission of the Fire District, subject to the assignment and direction of their supervisor, and in accordance with District policies, procedures, and standards.

**Report to:** Fire Lieutenant

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Responds to emergency incidents and performs assigned firefighter and emergency medical tasks in accordance with Fire District 8 and Washington State standards.
2. Participates in training, pre-fire planning, hydrant testing, emergency medical treatment, fire suppression, operation of equipment, public education, fire prevention, maintenance activities and other duties as may be assigned.
3. Drives and operates fire department apparatus in accordance with applicable state laws and District policies and procedures.
4. Performs routine maintenance of apparatus, vehicles, equipment, grounds, and buildings to assure that they are in a continual state of readiness and safety, in accordance with applicable standards and District policies and procedures. Assures that apparatus, vehicles, equipment, grounds and buildings are clean and presentable to the public at all times.
5. Completes all required reports utilizing assigned computerized record and reporting programs.
6. Fulfills the role of company officer in the case of absence of a company officer, as assigned by a chief officer.
7. Work schedule will be scheduled as necessitated by the District and may be modified from time to time to meet the needs of the District.
8. Performs such other duties as may be assigned within the scope of the position.

**Type of Education:**

High school graduation or equivalent. Must have IFSAC Firefighter I certification or equivalent documented training. Washington State EMT certification required. College level coursework or degree desired in the areas of: Fire Science, Fire Command Administration, or any combination of experience, education, and training that would provide the level of knowledge, skills and abilities required to be successful in the position.

**Physical Requirements:**

Must pass District's firefighter physical ability test. Must pass and maintain District's minimum medical and health standards physical.

**Other Requirements:**

Must pass written exam, panel interview, drug testing, and background investigation. Must maintain valid Washington State driver's license.
