NOTICE OF RECRUITMENT

CAREER FIREFIGHTER ***Salary Range: \$54,415 - \$62,988***

The Position: Spokane County Fire District 8 will be testing to create an eligibility list for full-time Firefighter-E.M.T's. The eligibility list may be used to fill currently authorized positions, as budget allows, as well as future vacancies.

The District: Spokane County Fire District 8 provides a full range of services to approximately 21,100 citizens in 110 square miles of beautiful urban, suburban and rural areas on the southern borders of the City of Spokane and the City of Spokane Valley. The area's many lakes, rivers, streams, mountains, and entertainment venues provide for a wide range of recreational and cultural activities. The District personnel include: 32 full-time staff, approximately 50 volunteer staff, 14 temporary-hourly employees, and a resident firefighter program with up to 10 personnel. The District is governed by an elected three member Board of Fire Commissioners serving staggered six-year terms.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Graduate or equivalent
- IFSAC Firefighter I certification or equivalent training
- National Registry or Washington State EMT-Basic certification
- College level coursework or degree desired in the areas of: Fire Science or Fire Command Administration, Emergency Medicine, or any combination of experience, education, and training that would provide the level of knowledge, skills and abilities required to be successful in the position.
- Possess and maintain Valid Drivers License

Written Exam and Physical Ability Testing: Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications will be invited to participate in a Written Exam. Candidates will be notified of written exam eligibility and written and physical ability exam times during the week of April 1, 2012. The written exam will be administered on April 13, 2012 and the physical ability exam will be administered on April 14, 2012.
