Purpose: Incident Type Response.

References: N/A

Procedure:

1. Incidents are dispatched per the designated run card from SREC/Fire Comm.

2. It is the intent of the run cards to initiate the appropriate response to incidents and notify volunteers and additional staff for response or station stand-by.

3. Primary dispatched apparatus shall respond with the on-duty station personnel.

4. Volunteers, and callback Career and Part-Time staff shall staff additional dispatched apparatus for response or provide station stand-by.

- 5. Some incidents may not require all dispatched units to respond directly to the incident.
- 6. The primary apparatus or Incident Commander (IC) may cancel additional apparatus if not required.
- 7. If a dispatched unit is canceled or does not need to respond, the unit should be placed back in-service with SREC/Fire Comm.
- 8. The following are response guidelines only:
 - a) BLS Medical (31A, 31B).
 - i. The personnel and apparatus dispatched by SREC/Fire Comm shall respond.
 - ii. If the responding apparatus requires or needs additional equipment they shall request through SREC/Fire Comm.
 - b) ALS Medical (31C, 31D, 31E).
 - i. The personnel and apparatus dispatched by SREC/Fire-Comm shall respond.

If the responding apparatus requires or needs additional equipment they shall request through SREC/Fire Comm.

- c) Vehicle Accident (46A, 46B, 46C, 46D, 46E).
 - i. The personnel and apparatus dispatched SREC/Fire Comm shall respond.
 - ii. If the responding apparatus requires or needs additional equipment they shall request through SREC/Fire Comm.

- d) Vehicle Fire (13S).
 - i. The personnel and apparatus dispatched by SREC/Fire Comm shall respond.
 - ii. If the responding apparatus requires or needs additional equipment they shall request through SREC/Fire Comm.

 - i. The personnel and apparatus dispatched by SREC/Fire Comm shall respond.
 - ii. If the responding apparatus requires or needs additional equipment they shall request through SREC/Fire Comm.
