Purpose: To ensure the risks to Spokane County Fire District 8 are identified, analyzed, and managed so that they are maintained at acceptable levels.

References: N/A

Procedure:

- 1. The Fire District will utilize risk management procedures in conjunction with an Incident Action Plan (IAP) at all emergency operations.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the Incident Commander to evaluate the risk to members with respect to the purpose and potential results of their actions in each situation (risk vs. gain).
- 3. Risk assessments shall be an on-going process until incident operations are terminated.
- 4. The concept of risk management shall be utilized on the basis of the following principles:
 - a) Within a structured plan:
 - i. We will risk a lot to save life.
 - ii. We will risk a little to save property and valuables at risk.
 - iii. We will risk nothing to save that which is already lost.
