Purpose: To ensure safety for firefighters during wildland firefighting operations.

References: WAC 296-305-07004

Procedure:

- 1. At wildland fires, members shall be provided with a minimum of one quart per hour of electrolyte drinks or potable water.
- 2. Officers at a wildland fire shall be trained in the symptoms of heat-related disorders and shall observe their crews for such behavior. Appropriate action shall be taken in the event of crew member displaying such symptoms.
- 3. One hour is the maximum time that individuals can work in high temperatures during a wildland incident in structural protective clothing.
