Purpose: To provide for the safety of all persons when responding near schools and school busses.

References: N/A

Procedure:

- 1. When responding to an emergency through school zones, the operator of the emergency response vehicle will adhere to and obey all traffic signs and speed limits.
- 2. This procedure also applies when approaching school buses.
- 3. When a school bus is stopped with its stop sign out and allowing children to exit the bus, Fire District 8 apparatus/vehicles will shut down all emergency lights and siren and come to a complete stop.
- 4. Only after the bus has cleared all of its warning devices and has moved to its right, to allow passing, will the emergency vehicle continue a code response.
- 5. At no time shall a Fire District vehicle exceed the posted speed limit through school zones.
