Purpose: To provide guidelines for moving out of District for station coverage.

References: N/A

Procedure:

1. Move-Up or Out-of-District Coverage.

- a) District 8 apparatus may be moved to any station within Spokane County.
- b) If we receive an out-of-district request for an <u>immediate need</u> response we will respond <u>immediately</u> and backfill our vacated station as outlined in #3 below.
- 2. When District 8 receives an out-of-district request for station coverage, we will move-up for coverage at the discretion of the on-duty 820 officer.
 - a) A Station 81 move-up will require Engine 82 to be moved to Station 81.
 - b) A move-up or response by both Engine 84 and Engine 85 requires Engine 82 to move-up to Station 84.
 - c) Engine 82 will begin the call back process to staff Fire District apparatus and stations as needed.
 - i. If companies are moved-up for coverage, qualified volunteers will be requested for backfill.
 - ii. If no qualified volunteers are available the on-duty 820 will determine callback needs and authorized overtime for full-time and part-time firefighters.
 - iii. If companies are assigned to a working fire, FTE, PTFF, VOD, and Volunteer personnel may be called back to staff District apparatus and stations.
- 3. Every effort should be made to staff an <u>engine company</u> that moves out-of-district for coverage with three-persons, although there may be circumstances where this is not feasible due to available staff. Brush companies may be staffed back to two-persons.
- 4. The covering apparatus staff shall respond as dispatched and monitor designated dispatch frequencies. The apparatus will use its assigned designator during response.
 - a) If covering apparatus requires an unstaffed engine to be staffed, the on-duty 820 will ensure that the engine is in service with Dispatch.
