**Purpose:** To provide a guide when responding to a multi-casualty incident (MCI).

**References:** Spokane County Field Operations Guide (FOG).

**Procedure:**

1. MCI's occurring within Fire District 8 will be managed utilizing the direction provided by the Spokane County Multi-Casualty Incident Field Operations Guide (FOG).
2. The Fire District's MCI equipment is located on the first-due EMS unit at Station 82 and should be utilized as needed to manage the incident. This equipment includes:
  - a) Additional triage tags.
  - b) Color-coded treatment area tarps.
  - c) Color-coded treatment area flags.
3. Incident commanders should consider activation of regional MCI equipment trailers to bring additional equipment to the scene as well as busses to provide shelter to walking wounded patients.
