Purpose: To establish the radio talk group usage plan as set forth by the Dispatch Center.

References: N/A

Procedure:

1. Spokane County Fire District 8 and its personnel shall follow the radio talk group usage plans as set forth by the Dispatch Center.
 - a) **USAGE GUIDELINE:** the Dispatch Center radio system will consist of zones and talk groups. The STATUS channel will generally be used for non-emergency radio traffic. Dispatch does not need to be notified of a resource being out of their station, unless they would not be in their first in response area.
 - b) All dispatches will be done over digital pagers, and resources will generally respond on an assigned talk group that will be predetermined by geographical area. Dispatch will include in the initial dispatch the assigned talk group to all responding units. Additional talk groups may be requested from dispatch for large incidents and/or as needed. Responding resources will report they are responding, on scene, to an incident on their assigned talk group. When resources are returning from an incident, they will notify dispatch on their talk group of their status.
 - c) Additional groups shall be utilized for:
 - i. Coordinating the response of multiple field units to a situation.
 - ii. Necessary radio traffic between field units for information exchange.
 - iii. Major events generating a volume of radio traffic which may interfere with normal radio operations.
 - d) Involved field units shall identify on the initial talk group that they are switching to a secondary talk group. Dispatch will monitor all in use talk groups when possible.
2. Zones and Talk Groups: A zone is comprised of 16 talk groups. A talk group is a position on your radio consisting of a group of users. Talk groups consist of a zone and a channel. Example: Zone Bravo Channel 3 is Spokane Regional Operations 3 (SR OPS3).

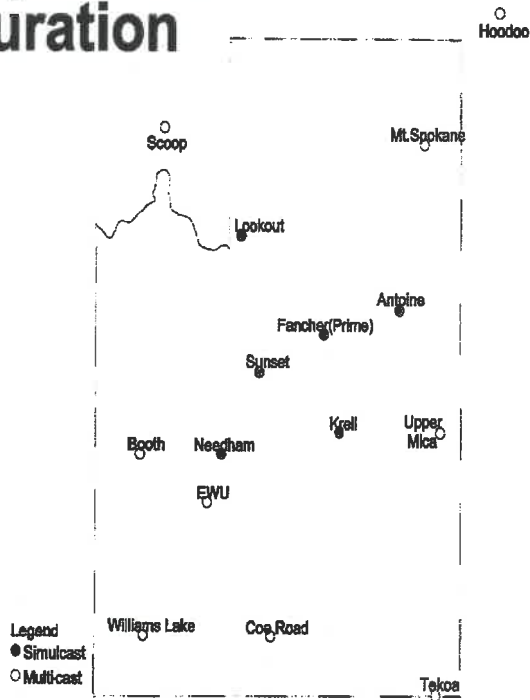
