## Smoke Alarms, Make Them Work For You!



DID YOU KNOW that roughly 60% of home fire deaths happen in homes with no smoke alarms or no working smoke alarms?

DID YOU KNOW that you may have less than two minutes to escape your home once the smoke alarm sounds?

**Fire moves fast, and every second counts.** Working smoke alarms give you early warning so you can get outside quickly. Working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in a home fire in half.

#### Smoke alarms, how do you make them work for you?

- 1. **INSTALL** smoke alarms in every **bedroom**, outside each separate sleeping area (like a **hallway**), and on **each level** (including the basement) of the home.
- 2. **TEST** smoke alarms at least **once a month** by pushing the test button.
- **3. REPLACE** all smoke alarms when they are **10 years** old or stop responding when tested.
